It is the intent of the Board of Education of Frederick County to develop policies to serve as guidelines for its own operations and for the successful and efficient functioning of the public schools.

The board considers policy development one of its chief responsibilities. Proposals regarding policies may originate with a member of the board, the superintendent, staff members, parents, students, consultants, civic groups, or other residents of Frederick County. Proposals for policy discussion shall be in accordance with Policy 102.2 as it relates to placing items on the board's agenda.

The superintendent is given the continuing responsibility of calling to the board's attention all policies that are out-of-date or for other reasons appear to need revision. Adoption of new policies or the revision or repeal of existing policies is solely the responsibility of the board. The board shall periodically devote time for policy review throughout the year.
