Early entrance to kindergarten in FCPS is limited to students who demonstrate advanced academic skills in literacy and math in alignment with the Ready to Read Act, the Maryland Comprehensive Literacy Plan, and the FCPS Comprehensive Literacy Plan. FCPS strictly adheres to expectations that students eligible for early entrance demonstrate advanced skills, scoring "above benchmark" on composite scores for English Language Arts and Mathematics. Eligible students must also demonstrate developmental, social and emotional readiness.
