3. Other Facts:

- Regulation 200-030, Pre-qualification of Contractors for Construction Services establishes a procedure for qualifying
 roofers for large roofing projects. Roofing contractors will be evaluated on their qualifications, experience,
 manufacturer authorization and certifications, financial information, and other pertinent data. Only the most qualified
 companies will be recommended as eligible to receive bidding documents for roofing projects over \$250,000.00.
- The qualification period will be effective for a five-year period, from the date of award through December 31, 2018.
 The qualification period may be extended on an annual basis for three additional years. Annually, during the life of the contract, Frederick County Public Schools (FCPS) will accept letters of interest from prospective contractors to become qualified. The open enrollment period will be September 1 through September 30.
