- A. **Overview:** This recommendation to establish a contract for the repair, removal, and/or installation of bituminous concrete to various locations throughout Frederick County Public Schools (FCPS). Bids were opened on October 17, 2017.

1. **Bid participation:**

22 proposals downloaded
2 companies submitted a bid

2. **Bids were received from:**

Finley Asphalt & Seating, Inc. (Bristow, VA)
RFP, Inc. dba: Remsburg Family Partnership (Middletown, MD)

3. **Other Facts:**

- The contract will be effective from the date of award through October 31, 2019, with two additional two-year renewal options available.
- Pricing is stated in terms of cost per unit of labor and/or materials. All prices will remain firm through the initial contract period.
- Selection was based on a total score of each contractor's technical and price proposals.
- Approximately \$346,119 was spent in FY17.
- This contract will to be administered by Gary Barkdoll, FMP, Manager of Maintenance Projects and Grounds in the Maintenance Department.

4. **Source of Funding:** FY18 Approved Operating Budget and contingent upon Board approval of FY19 and FY20 Operating Budget.
