### 3. Other Facts:

- Eleven contract packages were bid in two phases to allow selected activities of work to be started with available FY20 project funds. The contract packages include: 2A Site Work, 3A Concrete, 4A Masonry, 5A Steel, 6A General Carpentry, 7A Roofing, 8A Windows and Storefronts, 9A Drywall and Acoustics, 11A Food Service, 15A Mechanical and 16A Electrical. Phase two activities of these contract packages, including selected alternates, plus the remaining five contract packages is contingent upon FY21 funding approval. The remaining contract packages include: 9B Tile, 9C Fluid Applied & Terrazzo Flooring, 9D, Resilient Flooring & Rubber Athletic Surfacing, 9E Painting, and 11B Athletic Equipment.
- The bid received from ProFast Commercial Flooring, LLC was considered non-responsive because all required bid forms were not included.
- The single bid received for contract package 9C, Fluid Applied and Terrazzo Flooring is recommended for rejection and
- The apparent low bid for contract package 16A, Electrical, received from Arco Electric, was requested to be withdrawn due to a mathematical error in their bid pricing.
- It is anticipated that Construction Stage II will commence on or around April 1, 2020, with substantial completion achieved by June 30, 2021.
- The architect for this project is GWWO Architects of Baltimore, MD. The construction manager for this project is Oak Contracting, LLC.
- The contract will be administered by Bradley Ahalt, Senior Project Manager, Planning and Construction Management.
- Source of Funding: FY20 Approved Capital Improvements Projects Budget and contingent upon Board approval of FY21 Capital Improvements Projects Budget.
