3. Other Facts:

- Contractor shall provide all labor, material, equipment, and supervision necessary for the completion of Precast Epoxy Terrazzo Stair Treads and Risers, Resinous Matrix Terrazzo Flooring and Fluid-Applied Flooring in accordance with the contract documents.
- It is anticipated that construction will commence on or around July 1, 2020, with substantial completion achieved by June 11, 2021.
- The architect for this project is GWWO Architects of Baltimore, MD. The construction manager for this project is Oak Contracting, LLC.
- The contract will be administered by Bradley Ahalt, Senior Project Manager, Planning and Construction Management.
- 4. **Source of Funding:** FY20 Approved Capital Improvements Projects Budget and contingent upon Board approval of FY21 Capital Improvements Projects Budget.
