QUESTIONS/ANSWERS**

1. Section 22. Multi-Agency Participation, notes FCPS reserves the right to extend the terms and conditions of this solicitation to any and all other agencies within the state of Maryland, as well as, any other federal, state, municipal, county, or local governmental agency under the jurisdiction of the United States and its territories.

Answer: This language simply gives other agencies the ability to piggyback this bid for their requirements in lieu of bidding as long as the contracted vendor agrees to honor all terms, conditions, and prices established in the contract.

What agencies has FCPS previously offered solicitations to? Is it the intent of FCPS to extend the terms and conditions of this agreement to agencies located outside the state of Maryland?

Answer: I do not have data that would support whether or not any other agencies are piggybacking this contract. This language does allow for agencies located outside of the state of Maryland to piggyback this bid with the approval of the contracted vendor.

2. Please advise if the Signature Acknowledgement Form noted in Section 3. e. ii. on page 9 of the RFP is the Signature Acknowledging Cost Proposal Form on page 36 of the RFP.

3. Section 7.i Additional Insured

May we ask whether it is the FCPS intent to insist upon additional insured status and primary/non-contributory requirement under professional liability insurance?

Answer: Yes, it is FCPS's intent to require additional insured on all vendor's policies. When this contract is utilized on State funded projects, this is a requirement of the State and the County.

4. Cost/Price Proposal Form:

Under Inspection services – Core Boring, can you clarify if that is for concrete or geo?

Answer: Geotech core boring.

5. Can you please let me know who is the incumbent firm for this solicitation?
