3. Other facts:

- The contract period will be from the date of award through June 30,2023, with four, one-year
 renewal options available. Contract renewal shall be invoked at the sole discretion of the Board of
 Education. Upon submission of bid, the vendor consents to the possibility of a contract renewal as
 a condition of award.
- Proposals were evaluated by a committee consisting of Frederick County Public School (FCPS) staff. Selection was based on the total score of each vendor's technical and cost proposal.
- Cost Proposals were scored for the four highest technical score recipients.
- The contract will be administered by Dr. Kevin Cuppett, Executive Director, Curriculum, Instruction and Innovation PreK-12.
- 4. Source of Funding: FY23 Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER), part of the Federal governments COVID-19 response and contingent upon Board approval of FY24, FY25, FY26 and FY27 Operating Budgets, should the services continue upon grant expiration, the services are identified as still required, and no new grant has been received.
