#### 1. Other facts:

- The contract renewal period will be effective July 1,2022 through June 30, 2023, with three, oneyear renewal options available. Contract renewal shall be invoked at the sole discretion of the Board of Education. Upon submission of bid, the vendor consents to the possibility of a contract renewal as a condition of award.
- No price adjustments were requested for this renewal.
- The contract will be administered by Dr. Kevin Cuppett, Executive Director, Curriculum, Instruction and Innovation PreK-12.
- Source of Funding: FY23 Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER), part
  of the Federal governments COVID-19 response and contingent upon Board approval of FY24, FY25,
  and FY26 Operating Budgets, should the services continue upon grant expiration, the services are
  identified as still required, and no new grant has been received.
