#### RFP 22MISC11 CRISIS INTERVENTION SERVICES

#### FACT SHEET

A. **Overview:** This recommendation is to establish a contract to provide crisis intervention training for staff using a train-the-trainer model. Proposals were opened April 13, 2022.

#### 1. **Proposal participation:**

6 proposals downloaded 4 companies submitted proposals

#### 2. Proposals were received from:

Crisis Prevention Institute, Inc. (Milwaukee, WI) Intervention Support Service, LLC (Clayton, GA) Professional Crisis Management Association, Inc. (Sunrise, FL) **The Mandt System, Inc. (Richardson, TX)** 

#### 3. Other Facts:

- The initial contract term shall be effective from the date of award through June 30, 2023, with the
  option to be renewed for four additional one-year periods. Renewal will be invoked at the discretion
  of the Board of Education.
- The scope of work under this contract includes, but is not limited to all training content materials for train-the-trainer model instructor certification, instruction in skills and strategies for preventing escalation, nonverbal and verbal de-escalation strategies, exclusion strategies, escort strategies, staff behavior and how it influences outcomes in a crisis, physical disengagement strategies, risk assessment and decision making, post-incident debriefing.
- A committee of FCPS staff independently reviewed and evaluated each proposal. The three highest scoring firms were interviewed. Following the interview process, the cost proposals of the two highest firms were evaluated. Selection is based on the total score of each bidder's technical and cost proposals.
- This contract will be co-administered by Dr. Linda Chambers, Director of Special Education (Secondary Programs) and Troy Keller, Director of Special Education (Elementary Programs).
- 4. **Source of Funding:** FY23 Approved Operating Budget and contingent upon Board approval of FY24, FY25, FY26 and FY27 Operating Budgets.
- B. **Recommendation:** Staff recommends that RFP 22MISC11, Crisis Intervention Services, be awarded to The Mandt System, Inc. at a cost of \$42,731 for year one.
