- In FY22, FCPS received \$110,300 in revenue share fees for time spent on the solicitation and contract management.
- Pricing through the Request for Proposal is based on a Fixed Fee Per Case.
- Approximately \$3.4 million was spent during FY22.
- This contract will be administrated by Robert Kelly, Director of Food and Nutrition Services Department.
- Source of funding: FY23 Approved Food and Nutrition Services Operating Budget and contingent upon Board approval of the FY24, FY25, FY26 and FY27 Food and Nutrition Services Operating Budgets.
