ADDENDUM NO. 1

This addendum is being issued primarily in response to the questions and comments provided by prospective bidders at the June 30, 2010, Pre-bid Meeting. It modifies or amends the bid instructions or terms of the original June 21, 2010, Request for Proposals, and summarizes points of discussion, as follows:

 THE DUE DATE FOR PROPOSALS IS EXTENDED. THE DUE DATE FOR PROPOSALS IS NOW JULY 19, 2010 NOT LATER THAN 2:00 PM LOCAL TIME. Any proposal received after this date/time will be returned unopened to the bidder. Be advised of the following revised timeline for other bid activities:

Convene Proposal Review Committee: July 22, 2010 Submit Proposed PPA Contract(s) for Review to BOE Attorney: July 26, 2010 Target Date for Attorney Feedback: August 2, 2010 Short List/Bidder Interviews as Required: August 3 through 5, 2010 Selection of Bidder: August 10, 2010 Contract award recommendation to BOE: August 18, 2010 Notice of Contract award to Bidder: August 19, 2010. MEA required date for execution of contract with awarded Bidder: August 27, 2010

These dates supersede dates referenced throughout the RFP. Project Schedule dates remain unchanged.

- **3.** Bidders are required to submit (1) one Original and (3) three Copies each of the Technical Proposal and the Price Proposal, in separate envelopes, to the
- 4. The Technical and Price Proposals <u>must</u> be in separately, sealed packages. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in disqualification of the bid. The Price Proposal will remain sealed until FCPS determines if your firm's submission is satisfactory according to the technical criteria in the RFP.
- 5. Page 23, Para. J. Performance Bond Replace this paragraph with the following:

The selected Bidder will be required to provide **Performance and Payment** bonds covering the possible failure of the contractor to perform its existing obligations under the contract for all phases of construction/installation of the solar array including the successful commissioning anticipated by April 1, 2011. The bonds shall be written in the total amount of the full value of the construction cost of the Solar PV system as stated on the bid sheet and shall be provided to BOE within five (5) business days after receipt of Notice of Award of the Contract. All proposals shall be based upon providing these bonds at no cost to BOE.

Each bidder shall address in their Technical Proposal what assurance or performance guarantees if any they can propose to provide to WCBOE in the PPA for the following potential future events:

- **1.** Cost and Performance to remove the solar photovoltaic (PV) electric generating system during the term of the PPA in the event the project does not generate the quantity of energy anticipated.
- 2. In the event the Bidder goes out of business or changes its core business activities to no longer include PV /electricity.
- **3.** Cost and Performance to continue to maintain the solar photovoltaic (PV) electric generating system for the period of the term of the PPA in the event the project does not generate the quantity of energy anticipated.
- 4. Bidders shall address in their Technical Proposal their ability to meet the required minimum bonding capacities. Bidders shall further address their ability to <u>exceed</u> the minimally required bonding capacity to accommodate the whole magnitude of the BOE program maintaining performance and the system under a Performance/Contract Bond with a 20 year term. Include the name of the Bidder's bonding agent and sureties or insurance companies who would underwrite the bonds. The cost of the 20-year term Performance bond shall be stated as a separate optional cost where requested on the Cost Proposal Form for informational purposes only.
- **5.** The Cost and Performance at conclusion of the PPA for Bidder to remove the array system, restoring the roof /building to same condition as non-involved roof areas, at the end of the term of the PPA.
- 6. Section K, Page 16, Insurance: "Each Participant" and "Participants" shall be replaced with "BOE".

7. The evaluation criteria is Section 4, Item B of the RFP has been changed as follows:

## **Evaluation Criteria**

- a. The Evaluation and Selection Committee will examine and evaluate each Proposal according to a uniform set of criteria, consisting of the following categories:
  - Price of power offered through the PPA for year one, contract duration of the PPA, and the subsequent increases in the price over the term of the PPA. (40 points)
  - 2) Review and evaluation of the Draft and Final PPA Agreement (20 points)
  - 3) Bidders estimated kWh production output of the proposed PV system in year one per the PPA (10 points)
  - 4) Experience and certification credentials of proposed team. (10 points)
  - 5) Demonstrated ability of the Bidder to install and have operational the stipulated photovoltaic capacity by the RFP deadlines. Disqualification is automatic if the Bidder cannot meet the deadline. (20 points)

- 8. The Bid Price Proposal Form and Signature Sheet has been changed and is attached
- 9. Utility Data Forms for Oakdale are not available for this addendum. They will be released in a second addendum on a later date.

# **QUESTIONS:**

## 1. Who was the vendor who installed the current roof?

The installer of the Oakdale High roof was Interstate Roofing. The age of the roof is currently 2 years. The roof is a 4 ply build up. The roofing contractor at Linganore High is Cole Roofing with a 4 ply build up.

2. Who is the manufacturer of the roofing materials?

The roof at Oakdale High was manufactured by GAF Corporation. The roof at Linganore High was manufactured by Tremco

3. Who is currently providing electrical service to the building? Is the school electricity currently being purchased under a third party contract?

The currently electricity provider is Allegheny Power. The school is not part of any third party contract for service.

# 4. What is the current credit rating for FCPS?

FCPS does not have its own credit rating. Frederick County's current bond ratings are:

- Fitch: AA+
- Moody's: Aa2
- S&P: AA+

5. *Who will be the signatory for the PPA?* The signatory for the PPA will be the FCPS Superintendent.
