<b>FIRE DRILLS IN SCHOOL BUILDINGS</b>	<b>POLICY 410</b>

Purpose: The Board of Education (Board) supports all efforts to promote a safe environment in its facilities and outlines its expectations to comply with Maryland law as it relates to mandatory fire drills for public school buildings.

Each Frederick County public school holds fire drills in accordance with the State Fire Prevention Code established under § 6–206 of the Public Safety Article, *Annotated Code of Maryland* and shall:

1. Keep records of these fire drills; and
2. Send a copy to the Superintendent.
