426 Fundraising in Schools

- A. The board acknowledges that student organizations and parent groups use fund-raising activities to support curricular and co-curricular endeavors. The raising and expending of funds by these groups should contribute to the educational experience of students and not conflict with or disrupt the operation of the instructional program.

All fundraising activities shall be approved by the principal or designee to insure adherence to board policy and regulation. It is the expectation that principals evaluate the time commitment involved for students to insure academic success is not compromised.

- B. Recognizing there are inherent concerns for student safety associated with door-to-door solicitations, the board advocates alternative efforts of selling such as telephone calls, parental assistance through personal or professional contacts, and parent or other adult supervision for any door-to-door solicitation by students.
