## I. Enrollment

- A. Enrollment in Frederick County Virtual School (FCVS) is an option for students who are currently enrolled, attending, and under the supervision of another Frederick County Public Schools (FCPS) school. The student's building of record will be the school assigned to the location of the student's residence.
- B. Full-time enrollment: FCVS offers a full-time remote learning option for all high school students and an option for upperclassmen to enroll full-time and take virtual courses to meet their remaining graduation requirements through FCVS supplemental programs. FCVS has more limited course offerings than a comprehensive high school.
- C. Supplemental enrollment: FCVS offers virtual courses for high school credit through multiple supplemental programs. These programs are open to any student currently enrolled and attending another FCPS school.

## II. Attendance

Expectations about attendance will be defined each year for each program and shared with parents, students, and the community.
