The following is a listing of item(s) your child will need to participate in his/her chosen program. Our programs are designed to prepare students to be college and career ready upon completion. After much discussion and several years of utilizing uniforms on a program by program basis, our school decided to require students to wear consistent clothing that is specific to and representative of the professional role that students are emulating. It has been our experience that having students wear professional uniforms allows them to seamlessly step out of their adolescent world and into the role of a young professional; bringing them closer together as a class and instilling a sense of pride in themselves and their program. An added benefit for some programs: students are not ruining their good/expensive clothes. Students not in compliance with these expectations will lose daily professionalism points, may be assigned alternative tasks, or may be removed from participating in the class; adversely affecting their grade. We do recommend two (2) uniforms in order to facilitate the laundering process on a regular basis.

Please note the following:

- ▶ For safety reasons, work boots are a requirement in many of the programs at the Center. If your student has chosen a program where work boots are required, he/she will need to have them **every day**. It is suggested that the students leave the boots in their lockers.
- ▶ Safety glasses will be provided free of charge to each student. If glasses are misplaced, lost or damaged, it is the student's responsibility to purchase new eye protection. Safety glasses may be purchased through the front office or any clear safety glasses that meet the ANSI Z87 standard will be acceptable.
- ▶ For students who wear glasses, we recommend that students purchase eyeglasses with safety lenses and side shields.
- ▶ The Center does provide locks for student lockers.
